You are entering the yard through the gate. The triangle in front of picture is planted with annual seeds.





You can see the hanging lights (that I bought in Canada last summer) and I have added 12 small path lights that don't show up well in the daylight. Also, note that the paths have grass to walk on and that it has been mowed recently. The next picture shows the daylilies in front and a lovely columbine on the upper left. The elm tree, the poplars, and the cottonwoods are just beginning to leaf out.





The next picture shows the top of the dry wash and that I am still working on the lower right corner. Again the lights go up this path as well as the one on the left.



This next slide is the tiny bit of grass that we have planted at this time. And, of course, the bench for resting. It is 8 feet long so in some of the pictures you can see how big the trunk of the elm is when compared.



The trees immediately on the outside of the fence are the poplars we planted three years ago. They are getting really tall. The plants in pots are my herbs and will go in a special place all together later.



You can see in the background of most of the pictures all the trees around us. It is a very green area in the midst of the sand and rocks. There aren't even any cactus here. More later.
